GROUPS

Book Club. Get together with fellow book enthusiasts to converse, discuss and debate current bestsellers and classics alike. Meets monthly in members' homes at 7 p.m. on Sundays.

Seniors Activity Group/60+. A very active group that attends functions such as plays, luncheons and tours, as well as meeting in members' homes for coffee.

Kneeland-Walker Volunteer Corps. Join your neighbors to help out the Wauwatosa Historical Society at special events that require additional volunteers, including the Firefly Art Fair or the Mystery at the Mansion, and for ongoing needs, such as seasonal gardening.

Helping Hands Support Group. A list of members that can be contacted when special help (meals, rides, etc.) is requested by one of our members. This group also serves lunch at the Hart Park Senior Center once a month.

Restoration Group. Serves as an important network of support and information for members interested in restoration or remodeling of their older homes.

Women's Bunco Group. Bunco is a dice game, easy to learn and enjoy. Join the women in your neighborhood for a fun evening of socializing and gaming!

Auto Enthusiast Club. If you like to talk about cars, admire cars or collect cars – new or old – this is the club for you.

Movie Club. Good movies can entertain, educate and inspire us; good discussion enhances the experience. Come to watch a movie or just come for the discussion the fourth Sunday of the month.

Dining Out Group. Try some of the Milwaukee area's hottest new restaurants and old standards while getting to know your neighbors better.

The Winers. The Winers offers members the opportunity to sample wines from all over the world. We meet in members' houses and take excursions to wineries and retail establishments.

The Green Team. Are you interested in being part of a group to exchange ideas about sustainability, urban homesteading, victory gardening, alternative energy, and all other things "green?"

Preschool Playgroup. Come play with us! Join the OHNA preschool play-group for coffee, snacks and fun.

TGIF Happy Hour. Open your home to a neighborhood TGIF. Good food, drink and new neighborhood faces lend to a casual and fun filled Friday evening.

Sheepshead. The Sheepshead card-playing group meets monthly. It is a "low-stakes" game combined with socialization, food and beverages. The group welcomes new participants of all skill levels and those who would like to learn the game.

Circle Suppers. Eat, drink and get to know our neighbors! Small groups gather in members' homes four times a year, rotating hosting and cooking responsibilities.

OHNA Neighborhood Garage Sale. Held the first weekend in June, our neighborhood garage sale is collectively advertised in local publications. Help is needed to place signs, etc.

Summer Picnic. Held on the grounds of the Kneeland-Walker mansion, the summer picnic is a great opportunity to meet new and longtime neighbors. Help is needed to plan and organize children's games, raffles, recipe contests, etc.

Movie Night. Grab a lawn chair, blanket and the kids for a family-friendly outdoor movie.

Nighttime Trick-or-Treating. Held on Halloween night, our neighborhood-sponsored event is enjoyed by young and old alike. Hosts are needed for cider stops.

Holiday Party. Traditionally held in the beautifully decorated Kneeland-Walker mansion in early December, the holiday party is an elegant affair that requires both planning and day-of help.

Easter Egg Hunt. Our annual egg hunt is held on the grounds of the Kneeland-Walker mansion the Saturday morning before Easter. Help is needed to fill and hide eggs.

DISTRIBUTING OHNA MATERIALS

OHNA relies on members to distribute newsletters and event fliers to their neighbors. Routes are generally 1-2 blocks long and near your home, and distributions usually occur 4-6 times per year.
